Conclusion

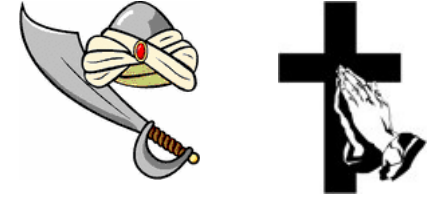

Islam: Invented by Mohammed. **Christianity:** Jesus is the fulfillment of Jewish prophecies.

Scriptural Authority
Islam: The Koran was dictated by Mohammed.
Christianity: The Bible consists of the Old and New Testaments.

Under Democracy
Islam: Does not fair well because questioning of religious authority is not allowed.
Christianity: Thrives because The Lord Jesus Christ has set His people free.

Assimilation
Islam: Very difficult in Western, European cultures.
Christianity: Possible in any location.

Islam: Systematic formation of religious terror.
Christianity: Embraces all the arts and sciences and freedom to worship.

Education

Christianity: Laws apply equally.

Islam: All laws favor men.

Society

Islam: Women are inferior.
Christianity: Women have equal value.

Spreading the Faith
